Malt The Brewery is a small, family-owned business with a local-focus, which was established in 2012. We seek to contribute to the community in which we live and work in a number of ways. In addition to providing meaningful employment opportunities and managing our environmental impact, we support a variety of local community initiatives.

Our charitable donations and community initiatives facilitate local projects that, like us, seek to make the world a happier, safer and tastier place.

We support local organisations that promote the advancement or wellbeing of people through a range of social, health and education initiatives.

Our policy is to make regular charitable donations during the year AND select one charitable organization that we support for the year; including the use of a collection box on the brewery Tasting Bar. In 2015, our customers and staff raised £300 for the Thames Valley Air Ambulance.

Who we support

Malt The Brewery donations are focused on small charitable organisations that:

- Work in the community close to our brewery in the Chiltern Hills
- Are ethically well-aligned with our business values
- Have been proposed by one or more Maltsters, our brewery club members

We consider applications from charities and non-profit organisations that demonstrate how a donation or gift will enhance the well-being of people through improved education, health/welfare or environment.

Your organisation does not need to be a registered charity, but it should be charitable.

We do not support

- Individuals who are looking for sponsorship for fundraising activities
- Initiatives that involve people participating in dangerous activities such as bungee jumping or parachuting

- Any initiative that contradicts the core statutory alcohol licensing objectives
- Any initiative that is outside of the criteria outlined in 'Who we support'
